Promotion and Outreach:

E-waste Recycle Solutions actively marketed the National Recycle Scheme conducting targeted leaflet mail-outs, and promoting the recycling of ewaste accumulated during the past year.

ASCEF Regional Expansion of Recycle Areas.

Ecycle Solutions and environmental education expanded our services and collaborations to previously unserved regional areas, collaborating with councils to reach a wider audience. Our Ecycle Solutions and education utilises strong collaborations and works diligently with its existing recycling partners to achieve these increased volumes. By the end of the year, these actions resulted in processing significant quantities bridging the gap to achieving the targeted recycling volume.

ASCEF Solutions has established enduring partnerships with 17 small to medium-sized specialist ewaste recyclers, some of which operate as social enterprises. The organizations mission is to expand its network ofe-waste recycle partners, nurturing and supporting these businesses from ewaste collections to the recovery of reusable materials downstream.

E-Waste Management

Central to ASCEF E-Waste we collaborated with specialised national recycling companies of the Environmental Protection Agency serving ,areas across, regional, and remote areas of Ghana. In the 2023/2024 years alone,ASCEF collaboration with the Environment Protection Agency and delivered over 5 million electrical appliances, utilising a modern fleet of over 150 state-owned vehicles, and collaborating with sub-contractors. These drivers collect purpose-builtewaste bins, which were filled with old televisions and computers .These collected devices were responsibly recycled.

Environmental Awareness Campaign

We help organize and educate the youth in urban areas about the movement of e-waste and hazardous wastes by ensuring its proper management and disposal in an environmentally for the sound regulations and manner in direct relation to Target 12.4 of SDG 12. We also advocate for increasing the ability of e-waste recycling plants to

Promote the proper and environmentally sound management of chemicals per the Basel Convention (SDG 12).

We created awareness and educated the youth about health hazards and physical injuries e-waste poses and the harm it causes to their health and environment, especially the soil.
